1. Call to Order  
The meeting was called to order at 1:08 pm.
2. Approval of Minutes  
Dick McKinley moved to approve the addition of two new members to WESTCAPS, Phoenix and Glendale. Troy Day seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Cliff Neal moved to approve the notes from the March 27, 2014 meeting. Dick McKinley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

3. Reports

Planning Committee Report

Jake Lenderking provided an update on the Planning Committee efforts and legislative items discussed. In addition, he noted that the Planning Committee would like to develop a follow-on letter for ADWR related to the Enhanced Aquifer Management Process, and asked for the Management Committee's okay to do that. Troy Day moved to draft a letter for the Chairman's approval to voice the opinion of West Valley water users as part of the Enhanced Aquifer Management Process. Mike Weber seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Executive Director's Report

Teresa Makinen briefly discussed the Leaders' Summit and also provided an update on the strategic planning efforts, which will be discussed more thoroughly at the next meeting. The Management Committee agreed it would be fine to discuss the status at the September Management Committee meeting and it should be placed on the agenda for that meeting.

Treasurer's Report

Jake provided an update on the financial status and noted that the Director is putting in quite a bit of time and we've been doing much more than originally anticipated. The group discussed this for a while and Dick McKinley moved that Larry Dobrosky and Jake Lenderking look at the multiparty agreement to make sure there is appropriate compensation for time and expenses.

Dick further moved that Larry Dobrosky and Jake Lenderking, as the Management Committee and Planning Committee Chairmen, review the additional work along with the additional revenue for Glendale and Phoenix being added as members and see if the Director's contract needs amending; and if it is reasonable, to make the change on behalf of the Management Committee. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

5. BOR Report

Mitch Haws provided an update on the Basin Study. Mike Weber moved to approve the Memorandum of Agreement for the Basin Study for the Lead Party's signature, with the addition of Glendale and Phoenix. Dick McKinley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
